Graduation Requirements

1. Participation in the graduation ceremony is not required. If you do not want to abide by the dress and behavior requirements, you and a parent will need to see Mr. Bush to discuss picking up your diploma.
2. The following dress requirements are for all seniors. If you have a problem getting the appropriate attire, please contact one of your sponsors immediately and we will try to work with you.
 - a. Girls may wear appropriate shorts and a sleeveless t-shirt under your gown or sundress. The neck of the shirt should not show under the gown, or be longer than the hem of the gown. Girls need black dress shoes with a back or strap around the back, flats or low heels are suggested.
 - b. Guys should have black or navy dress pants, black dress shoes, black socks, white dress shirt and dark tie or bow tie. These items may be borrowed from family or friends.
 - c. Large or dangling pieces of jewelry are not acceptable at graduation. Conservative jewelry and hair styles are best.
3. No gum.
4. Do not make work plans, doctor appointments or any other obligations during graduation week that will prevent you from attending school and remaining at school until your senior duties are complete.
5. Tickets for graduation will be issued during Friday's practice session.
 - a. Please deliver the tickets to family and friends who actually plan to attend the ceremony.
 - b. You will have a limited number of tickets; choose wisely who will get them.
 - c. **THERE ARE NO EXTRAS. IF YOU LOSE THEM, YOU WILL NOT GET ANY REPLACEMENTS.**
6. Report to the cafeteria at 6:00 p.m. on graduation evening. **ALL PARENTS AND GUESTS MUST ENTER THE SCHOOL AT THE GYM ENTRANCE. NO ONE IS ALLOWED IN THE CAFETERIA EXCEPT SENIORS AND SENIOR SPONSORS/FACULTY MEMBERS. PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL VALUABLES ARE GIVEN TO SOMEONE BEFORE YOU ENTER THE CAFETERIA.** All seniors will wear their cap, gown, and appropriate tassel as directed by the senior sponsors.

7. Marshall County Board Policy requires that to receive a high school diploma, students must earn 26 credits **and** complete all obligations to Marshall County High School. These obligations include attending all practices, working in a cooperative manner with sponsors and administration during practice, and conducting themselves in an appropriate manner during the graduation ceremony. Seniors will receive their diploma cover during the ceremony and will be issued the actual diploma in a designated area of the building following the ceremony.
8. Graduation is a special time for seniors and their families. No one has the right to spoil the happiness of others by unacceptable behavior. Please do not embarrass yourself, your family, classmates or your school by creating a situation that would result in your being removed from the graduation line, not being able to receive your diploma following the ceremony and/or other disciplinary action.
9. Be certain you have paid all fees and/or fines, returned all books and completed all Detention hours.
